Snack

God created me

Ingredients

- Cheerios cereals
- Strawberries (2 slices per child)
- Broccoli (2 pieces per child)
- Gummy words (1 per child)
- Paper plate (1 per child)
- Crayon



Instruction

1. Give one paper plate to each child.
2. On the plate, ask them to draw a face.
3. Ask the child to add the Cheerios for the hair.
4. Ask the child to add the strawberries for the cheeks.
5. Ask the child to add the broccolis for the eyebrows.
6. And for the lips, add the gummy worms.

Sport

Name the animal

Item

- Animals illustrations (download)

Instruction

1. Have the children sit in a circle.
2. Place visual aids in the center.
3. Give each child an animal illustration
4. Tell the children to pretend to help Adam name the animals.
5. Show one of the animal illustrations.
6. Ask the children to suggest incorrect names for the animal. They can suggest « elephant » or « zebra » when it is a rabbit, for example.
7. The child with the illustration in his or her hand must shake his or her head to say no until the animal's real name is suggested.

Discussion

- God asked Adam to name all the animals.
- Do you think Adam was happy to find a name for all the animals?
- What is the next animal we will name?



Activity

Mix and Match

Items

- Baskets
- 4 clotheslines
- Clothepins
- Clothes from different seasons

Instructions

1. Hang four clotheslines in your room to represent the four seasons.
2. Fill a few baskets with clothing from all seasons.
3. Children must sort the clothes and put them on the right clothesline.
4. Talk with the children about how God made the seasons.

Craft

Toilet Paper Roll Fall Tree Craft Using Fruit Loops

Materials Needed:

- Fruit loops cereal
- Glue
- White paper
- Toilet paper roll
- Scissors

Instructions

1. Start by having the kids sort out the colors they want on their tree.
2. Cut out the top of the tree with the white card stock paper and put glue all over it.



3. Have the kids stick on the fruit loops and press down.
4. Once that is dry, cut a two slits across from each other in the empty toilet paper roll.
5. Stick the paper inside and you've got yourself a tree!
6. Make sure to tell the kids that the cereal is not for eating after it's been glued because they are definitely tempted!!

Object lesson

God created you

Item

- Play dough



Instruction

1. Show the children the play dough.
2. With the play dough, create a human form.
3. Shape it according to what the children will ask you to do. (ex: big nose, small mouth)
4. Try bring it to life by blowing into the nostrils of the shape.
5. Explain that only God can give life to one of the clay as he did to Adam.

Bonus: You can let the children create a new friend and talk about how God created Adam.

Ice Breaker

Self discovery

Items

- Large sheet of paper
- Pencils
- Crayons
- Children silhouette

Instructions

1. Place a large sheet of paper on the floor
2. Ask a volunteer to lie on the sheet.
3. Draw the outline of his body.
4. Then bring the silhouette to a table.
5. Draw the face, hair, clothes, etc.
6. Give the children pencils and explain how to colour the silhouette.
7. If you have a large group, make several silhouettes.
8. While the children are coloring, sing a song about creation.

Optional: Give each child a copy of a child's silhouette. Ask each child to colour in the silhouette to make it look like him or her.



Heart of the father

Adam was the first man, the first husband, the first father, but also the first son. It was created by God Genesis 1:27 « created in the image of God ».

And he looks like God, he is the image of God.

You too were created in the image of God. Adam had God as his father just as you have God the Father as your father.

Psalms 139:16

« When I was just a formless mass, your eyes saw me... »

When you were very young in your mother's womb, God the father had his loving gaze on you. God wants to be a father to you, just as he was to Adam. Receive his love.



Prayer

Application: The father loves me

1. Show a mirror to the children
2. Children should look in the mirror and say this « I am the daughter/son of God the Father, God is my father and he loves me » Prière

If you want to spend more time talking about what you learned, here's a place to start.



- God put Adam and Eve in the Garden of Eden to “work it and keep it.” What do you think that meant? God trusted them to take care of his amazing creation! He wanted them to enjoy it. When you think about God’s creation, what are ways you can take care of it? What are ways we enjoy God’s creation as a family?
- When Adam and Eve chose to sin and had to leave the Garden of Eden, how do you think they felt?

Additional Prayer:

Prayer is a time to be quiet to talk with God, to thankfully reflect on what he has given to you, and to ask for His presence and help where you may need him, and to lift up other friends and family who may need him too. - Show us ways we can be good caretakers of your world and your people
- Be with our teachers from school as they rest this summer
- Help and heal those who cannot go to school and learn because they are sick (Do you know anyone who is sick who needs prayer?)

Connecting as a Family

Take time to reflect on your day, asking each member of the family to answer these questions. How do the answers shape your prayers?

- What did you feel good about today?
- Did anything difficult happen or cause you to feel disappointed?

Pray as a family.
